Police Committee Meeting
March 3, 2021 via Zoom at 7:00 p.m.

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Wilkendorf.

Those in attendance included: Police Committee members Matt Ginder & Nate Sauder, Daryl Wilkendorf, Police Committee Chairman, Village President Jim Edwards, Roger Mullins - Village Board member, Josh Nohl, PWA, Brad Potts - Chief Deer Creek Police Dept. and Nick Vlahos – Peoria Journal Star.

Purpose of meeting was to review the police services contract between Deer Creek Police Dept. and Village of Goodfield.

Chairman Wilkendorf asked Chief Potts to review last three years actual revenues and expenses for the department. Chief Potts answered questions and explained the revenues and expenses thoroughly. Chief Potts also commented on the ongoing training requirement for his officers.

Chief Potts outlined Deer Creek's theoretical budgeting principle in developing contract with Goodfield.

Chairman Wilkendorf asked all in attendance to offer feedback for Chief Potts. The general consensus of most of those present felt Goodfield was getting about the right amount of police presence.

Chief Potts explained Deer Creek was working on a contract for the coming year, and expected to have it available for Goodfield's next Board meeting.
