Police Committee / Health, Safety & Maintenance Committee Meeting
November 8, 2018 at the Village Hall at 6:00 p.m.

Committee Chairman Jim Edwards called the meeting to order at 6:00p.m. Committee member Terry Nohl was present. Also present were Trustees Roger Mullins and Nate Sauder, Public Works Administrator Josh Nohl, Clerk Sheri Martin, Attorney Tim Gronewold and Abby Reel. Absent were committee members Todd Perry and Matt Ginder. There being no quorum there was only discussion and no action taken.

The agenda for the meeting was to discuss the liquor ordinance.

The November 6, 2018 election results were noted as 276 No (not to continue the liquor prohibition) and 145 yes (to continue the liquor prohibition). These were results as posted on the county websites. The Village has not received the canvas of votes yet.

Abby thanked the Board and let them know the opening night for the Barn III is February 7, 2019. Abby also stated she has some bookings late December and early January. She would like the Village to contact her once our code and application process has been determined.

Chairman Edwards went through the liquor code with the committee and Attorney Gronewold.

Attorney Gronewold stated a time frame for passing liquor code may be to discuss the Ordinance at the November Regular Board Meeting then vote on Ordinance at the December Regular Board Meeting. Chairman Edwards stated he would like to have the Ordinance ready to vote on at the November Regular Board Meeting.

There was discussion about adding a section to say gaming would be prohibited in Goodfield. Attorney Gronewold will check into this but thinks it would be in another place in the code and not the Alcohol Chapter.

There was no further discussion.
