

# Village of Goodfield

## Police Committee Meeting

March 12, 2018 at the Village Hall at 7:00 p.m.

Committee Chairman Jim Edwards called the meeting to order at 7:15p.m. Committee member Terry Nohl was present. Absent was Committee member Wade Wettstein.

The agenda for the meeting was to continue discussion on a possible liquor ordinance.

Police Chairman Edwards began the discussion with the preface that the committee is meeting in anticipation that the Village may need to have a liquor ordinance in place in the future. He does not want any misunderstanding, the Village Board is not advocating for or against the question of should the Village remain "dry" or not but is trying to be prepared in case we do need an ordinance.

Points of discussion that carried over from the February Police Committee meeting were as follows:

1. Whether to have a Local Liquor Control Commissioner and/or Commission vs. Board of Trustees.  
*It was the consensus of the committee to have the Village President be the Local Liquor Commissioner and the approval of 2/3 of the Board of Trustees required to approve his recommendations to grant and or suspend for not more than thirty days or revoke for cause all retail liquor dealer's licenses issued to persons for premises within the Village.*
2. Compensation for Local Liquor Commissioner was discussed.  
*It was the consensus of the committee that the Local Liquor Commissioner should be paid \$300/year.*
3. The committee discussed a non-refundable fee payable for an initial retail liquor license.  
*It was the consensus of the committee to charge a \$150 non-refundable fee payable for an initial retail liquor license.*

Further discussion included reviewing the Mackinaw liquor code and changing it to match what Goodfield would need in our Ordinance, starting with Section 113.040 and ending at Section 113.460 of Mackinaw's code. See attached Code with changes.
