

Village of Goodfield

Police Committee Meeting

March 20, 2018 at the Village Hall at 7:00 p.m.

Committee Chairman Jim Edwards called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m. Committee members Terry Nohl and Wade Wettstein were present. Also present were Public Works Administrator Josh Nohl, Assistant PWA Mike Carr and Clerk Sheri Martin.

The agenda for the meeting was to discuss the Police Contract.

The proposal from Deer Creek shows a 10% increase for Goodfield – from \$79,310.00 in FY 2018 to \$87,241.00 in FY 2019. The committee has a problem with the fact that Goodfield is paying a 10% increase and Deer Creek only has a 3% increase.

Another issue is whether Goodfield needs patrol on Saturday during the day and why Deer Creek did not ask if we want patrol hours on Saturday. The \$.50 an hour raises to patrolman and administrative assistant is not an issue.

There was some discussion on comparing the cost if Goodfield had our own Police Department verses the amount we are paying Deer Creek for police service. It was the consensus of the Committee to recommend accepting a 7% increase for the coming year but that we should look into this before this contract is up. The committee would also like to see a breakdown of hours spent in Goodfield vs. hours spent in Deer Creek vs. hours spent on Interstate.

There was no further discussion.

Meeting adjourned at 7:32p.m.
