STREETS AND ALLEYS COMMITTEE MEETING February 29, 2012

Meeting was called to order at 1:00p.m. The following were present: Streets & Alleys committee members Mike Grimm and Terry Nohl, Village President Ross Hohulin, Village Engineer Duane Yockey, Railroad representative Joe Parisi, IDOT representatives Sue Eckoff and Randy Hopper, PWA Roger Mullins, Wastewater Operator Josh Nohl and Trustee Wade Wettstein.

Subject of the meeting is Rte. 117 railroad crossing repair.

IDOT representatives stated a Signed Detour on state highways to detour truck traffic is required and the contractor could charge up to twelve thousand dollars. The only vehicles allowed to go through town would be cars and light trucks so there should not be any street damage. IDOT would prefer a concrete repair rather than bituminous asphalt and the railroad estimated four to five days to complete work.

IDOT will check to see if there is money available for detour and possibly cost sharing with the Village. They will try to let Village know prior to March Regular Board Meeting. Railroad would like to do the repair in early June as soon as school is out. Friday, May 18 is last day of school.
