Water and Sewer Committee Meeting

March 29th 2012.

Meeting was called to order at 4:30 pm at the Village Hall. Present were: Water/sewer committee members Mike Grimm and Terry Nohl, Trustee Josh Kuntz, PWA Roger Mullins, Wastewater Operator Josh Nohl, and Village Engineer Duane Yockey.

Subject of meeting was sewer trunk line upgrade from town to sewer plant.

Sewer trunk line from town to sewer plant is approaching capacity and will need updated in near future. Engineer Yockey said there are different possibilities: run a new-parallel line next to current line, or use new technology to expand the existing line. The committee studied drawings of where the line runs, and where the manholes are.

The group then went to sewer plant and walked the trunk line toward town up to the 5th manhole to get a feel for the dense timber and hills that could hinder construction. All committee members agreed that clearing the timber along the line is necessary, as there is over 30 years of growth along the line. Without clearing the easement, construction is impossible.

The committee recommends getting an excavation quote from a local contractor to clear the timber along the trunk line following the 30 ft easement that is in place.

Meeting adjourned at 5:30 pm.
