

**Village of Goodfield
Combined Streets & Alleys and Water and Sewer Committee Meeting
September 10, 2020 via Zoom at 7:00p.m.**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm. In attendance were Streets & Alleys Committee Chairman Nohl, Water & Sewer Committee Chairman Mullins, Water & Sewer Committee member Wilkendorf, President Edwards, PWA Nohl, and Engineer Yockey.

PWA Nohl opened the meeting with a brief synopsis of the agenda. He did not anticipate any recommendations would come from this meeting. The meeting was to go over what had happened with the storm sewer collection system in the past to get us where we are today. Also, to see what the plan is for future improvements, and if they are still relevant.

Also, to be discussed was an update on the sanitary sewer easements.

PWA Nohl discussed past events that prompted a storm water study to be done. There was some discussion on this. At this time PWA turned the floor over to Engineer Yockey.

Engineer Yockey went over the general layout of the storm sewer. He said there were no actual drawings of the storm sewer system. During the installation of the sanitary sewer, they took notes on sizes and location whenever they encountered any storm tiles. The map he presented is what came from their notes. He also discussed two other maps of the storm sewer system. Two options to divert water from overloaded trunk storm sewer and gain capacity. Option A was ideal but was the most expensive. Option B was a variation of option A that reduced the cost. He noted that a small part of the proposed improvements was done in '99. There was general discussion of the layout and improvement options between the trustees and Yockey. The over all consensus was the proposed improvements were still relevant, even though they were drawn up over 30 years ago.

PWA said since the storm water improvements were costly and not as high of a priority, he will continue to clean and televise the storm collection system and add manholes to improve maintenance. He also proposed some sort of fee to generate revenue for the storm water collection system maintenance and improvements, to possibly be discussed at a future meeting.

PWA gave a summery on where we are regarding the sanitary sewer easements. There was some brief discussion on that.

The meeting adjourned at 8:30 pm.
