

**Tax Increment Financing

The meeting was called to order at 6:45p.m. by Village President Jim Edwards. Present were: President Edwards, Attorney Mike Gifford, PWA Josh Nohl, Nick Agnew – Eureka Goodfield Fire Department and Village Clerk. No public was in attendance at the TIF Joint Review Meeting. Absent were: Rick Bauman – Montgomery Township, Mark Montoya – Eureka-Goodfield Fire Protection District and Stan Glacier – Woodford County Board.

Prior to the meeting all taxing bodies were mailed a copy of the annual TIF Report. The TIF report covers the activity of the Goodfield TIF District for the fiscal year (May 1, 2019 through April 30, 2020). President Edwards was available to answer any questions the taxing bodies presented.

Nick Agnew asked the following questions:

1. When does the TIF end? *Answer: TIF ends December 31 of 2021, but because taxes are paid in arrears payments will end in 2022.*

2. After the TIF ends will the money come directly to the Fire Department?  
*Answer: Yes, it will come from Woodford County and Tazwell County.*
