

Village of Goodfield

Police Committee Meeting
December 6, 2021 - 2:00 p.m.
At Village Hall – 114 S Eureka Street, Goodfield

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Wilkendorf. Present were: Police Committee member Matt Ginder, Daryl Wilkendorf - Police Committee Chairman, Village President Jim Edwards, Village Attorney Mike Gifford, Trustee – Terry Nohl, Brad Potts - Chief Deer Creek Police Dept. and Clerk Sheri Martin. Purpose of meeting was to review Deer Creek police contract adjustment/request, review previous Deer Creek police department expenses and to discuss Goodfield future police needs.

Chairman Wilkendorf, Village President and Attorney Mike Gifford gave a brief overview of the Deer Creek Police meeting they had just attended. Deer Creek did not make a recommendation to their Board to add another full time police officer. Daryl asked them what they want him to bring back to the Goodfield Police Committee meeting. They said that we have a contract until April 30, 2023. New contract will not be like the old contract. At this time they did not have a contract adjustment request.

Committee began discussion regarding what Goodfield would like when the contract ends. Edwards asked if we can get copies of their work schedules. Also are part time police scheduled for 8 hour shifts? Daryl believes they are. Chief Pott's joined the meeting late and confirmed part time staff work 8 hour shifts. Also explained days of the weeks worked.

Daryl is going to ask the Deer Creek Clerk for a 5 year expense and revenue stream, and will supply summary at next full Board meeting.
