

# Village of Goodfield

Police Committee Meeting

July 26, 2021 - 7:00 p.m.

At Village Hall – 114 S Eureka Street, Goodfield

Meeting called to order at 7:00 PM by Chairman Wilkendorf.

Present were: Police Committee members Matt Ginder & Nate Sauder, Daryl Wilkendorf - Police Committee Chairman, Village President Jim Edwards, Trustees – Terry Nohl and Roger Mullins, Brad Potts - Chief Deer Creek Police Dept. and Clerk Sheri Martin.

Purpose of meeting was to discuss code enforcement, attorney representation and fee dispersal. Discussed were what portions of the Village code should be enforced by the police. Chief Potts said Deer Creek's attorney Pat McGrath felt he should be the enforcer because of how the Police Contract is written. Any fine money or ordinance violation money would go to Deer Creek per the contract. Burning and yard waste was discussed at length. The consensus of the committee was that Business/Commercial burning ordinance should be different than residential.

Chief Potts informed the Board of concerns he has with Martin Drive. With the increase in businesses and traffic on Martin Road the speed limit needs to be addressed. Technically any township road unmarked is 55mph and any Village Road not marked is 30mph. The Village and Township need to coordinate together to get a consistent speed limit. The T is also problematic and should be a 3 way stop. There is a visibility problem if you are coming from the West. Trustee Nohl will contact Montgomery Township Supervisor and get his input.

Chairman Wilkendorf asked Chief Potts, in general, about the police environment as time goes on.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 8:00p.m
