

# Village of Goodfield

Police Committee Meeting  
February 10, 2022 – 6:30pm  
At Village Hall – 114 S Eureka Street, Goodfield

Meeting called to order at 6:30 PM by Chairman Wilkendorf. In attendance were: Police Committee members Matt Ginder and Nate Sauder, Daryl Wilkendorf - Police Committee Chairman, Village President Jim Edwards and Bill Lolley – Assistant Chief of Police. Various other members of the public joined during the meeting, principally to attend the following Code Review Committee Meeting scheduled for 7:00PM. Among them were Duane Yockey – Village Engineer and Mike Gifford – Village Attorney.

Purpose of the meeting was to review how the Police Department should be involved in enforcing Village ordinances. A draft document presented by President Edwards was circulated and reviewed. Discussion revolved around when, how and why to involve Police Department. The current Chief Potts will be retiring this summer and Assistant Chief Lolley will be taking the chief position, his attendance and comments were appreciated. Discussion continued about what Goodfield expected/desired from the police department, with future Chief Lolley's acknowledgement.

With the pending change in Police Department leadership, all agreed we should revisit this issue in a few months. Meeting adjourned at 7:08PM. No action was taken by the committee.
