

Village of Goodfield  
Police Committee Meeting Minutes  
February 13, 2024 @ 7:00pm  
At Village Hall

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Todd Perry @ 7:00 pm. Present were Police Committee Members Todd Perry and Terry Nohl. Also present were President Hank Melton, Trustees Terri Kuebler and Roger Mullins and Clerk Sheri Martin.

Cost Estimates from RAW Development were reviewed. The estimated budget for the office renovation project is \$9,110.00, which includes all labor, materials, and necessary permits. Cost associated with ALT 1 is \$927.00. Cost associated with ALT 2 is \$13,020.77. Total project costs equal \$23,057.77.

ALT 1 is an option for interview room to have insulated walls and upgraded door for sound containment.

ALT 2 is an option for reception area desk with one built in file cabinet running 13'6" north and south and 8' east and west with saloon style entry door on north side.

At an earlier meeting with Russ Wiegand he expressed he would be willing to stretch the cost for renovation out over the term of the lease.

Trustee Kuebler found a second option to consider for a Police office. Goodfield Shoe Repair would be willing to rent out part of their building. It has a garage, 900 sq. ft. and remodeling could be done by the Village. Rent would be \$900/month. There is only one bathroom, so that would have to be shared. The Committee thought sharing a bathroom would not be a good thing. The committee will keep moving forward with the Wiegand property we are presently working with.

President Melton asked the committee how long will we lease before we are able renovate and add onto Village Hall. The committee thought possibly 3 years.

The committee discussed the front reception desks and chairs. The consensus was that these could be purchased used. Someone will check with VIVO to see about desks. Chairman Perry will discuss this with Bill Lally. The committee would possibly like to meet with Russ Wiegand again. The Committee will also schedule one more Police Committee Meeting.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 7:55p.m.
